INDICATIONS

XPOVIO® (selinexor) is a prescription medicine approved:

- In combination with bortezomib and dexamethasone (XVd) for the treatment of adult patients with multiple myeloma who have received at least one prior therapy.
- In combination with dexamethasone (Xd) for the treatment of adult patients with relapsed or refractory multiple myeloma who have received at least four prior therapies and whose disease is refractory to at least two proteasome inhibitors, at least two immunomodulatory agents, and an anti-CD38 monoclonal antibody.
- For the treatment of adult patients with relapsed or refractory diffuse large B-cell lymphoma (DLBCL), not otherwise specified, including DLBCL arising from follicular lymphoma, after at least 2 lines of systemic therapy. This indication is approved under accelerated approval based on response rate. Continued approval for this indication may be contingent upon verification and description of clinical benefit in confirmatory trial(s).

HOW SUPPLIED

XPOVIO are blue, round, bi-convex, and film-coated 20 mg tablets with “K20” debossed on one side and nothing on the other side. Tablets are packaged in a child-resistant blister pack. Four blister packs are supplied per carton.
